

Christmas Tree Plushie

Embroidery

Instructions

Makes 1 Plushie Tree

1. Iron the interfacing onto the wrong side of the fabric squares.
2. Hoop wash away stabilizer in the hoop that suits the size of the embroidery design.
3. Load the design into the sew out screen of the embroidery machine.
4. Thread the machine with bobbinfil in the bobbin and embroidery thread in the top.
5. Sew out colour 1. This is the placement line for the fabric that will become the plushie.
6. Lay the fabric right side up over the stitch line.
7. Sew out colour 2. This is the seam line of the plushie when it is finished.
8. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the tinsel to be.
9. Sew out colour 3.
10. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the words to be.
11. Sew out colour 4.
12. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the trunk to be.
13. Sew out colour 5.
14. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the satin stitch in the shape of a tree to be.
15. Sew out colour 6.
16. Thread the machine with the colour that you wish for the star to be.
17. Sew out colour 7.

Requirements

- Embroidery Machine
- Hoop to suit design size
- Design Downloaded
- Transfer device, e.g. USB stick or iPad
- (2) – 8" x 8" fabric squares for the tree
- (2) – 8" x 8" iron on interfacing for the fabric
- Wash away stabilizer to fit hoop
- Toy stuffing
- Assorted embroidery threads to decorate and construct the embroidery.
- Bobbinfil on bobbins
- Hand sewing needles to sew the closure
- Scissors
- Snips
- Quick Unpick

Instructions continued

18. Take the second square of fabric and lay it right side down on top of the embroidery.
 19. Thread the machine with the same colour as the fabric.
 20. Sew out colour 8.
 21. Remove the design from the hoop.
 22. Trim the fabric back to ¼” from the stitch line and snip the curves.
 23. Rinse the stabilizer out of the design and dry.
 24. Turn the plushie through and stuff with toy stuffing.
 25. Using a hand sewing needle sew closed the opening.
- Your Christmas tree plushie is now complete.



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
